

## STATUTORY DECLARATION BY IRISH CITIZEN SEEKING “CERTIFICAT DE COUTUME” FOR MARRIAGE ABROAD

*(A divorced person or a person who is or intends to marry a person under the age of 18 years  
should use a different form)*

This declaration must be made and signed in the presence of one of the following:

In Ireland a Notary Public, a Commissioner for Oaths or a Solicitor.

Abroad before a Diplomatic or Consular Officer of Ireland, or Notary Public, a Commissioner for Oaths, or an equivalent person authorised to administer oaths or declarations in that place.
